AFGHAN OPERATION

Assisted Voluntary Repatriation (22 March – 30 June 2010)

UNHCR's Assisted Voluntary Repatriation program for Afghans in Pakistan began on Monday 22 March from Baleli Voluntary Repatriation Center (VRC) in Balochistan and the newly-established facilities, Chamkani, in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

The total number of Afghans who repatriated during 22 March - 30 June 2010 is **81,221** individuals.

General trends:

- Afghans returned largely from **Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (67%)** and **Balochistan (15%)** provinces of Pakistan
- The majority or **over 79% of returnees were Pashtun** followed by 10% Tajik.
- Close to **33%** of the Afghans returned to the **East** or the provinces (Kunar, Nangarhar, Laghman and Nuristan) and about **26%** went back to the **Central** provinces (Kabul, Logar and Parwan).
- Over **64%** of returnees were living in the **urban or semi-urban** areas of Pakistan while close to **36%** returned from refugee **villages**.

IRIS Verification

The Iris scanning and verification system was introduced in 2003. Initially it was for all returnees above the age of 12 years but later reviewed and reduced to those 5 years of age and above. Children below 5 years of age are not scanned due to the difficulty in getting them to focus on the scanning lense for the desired period of time. The Iris test is to ensure that the system is not abused and that 'recyclers' are identified and barred from receiving repatriation assistance more than once. The ratio of persons recognized at the Iris scanning stage i.e. rejected for repatriation by the Iris Recognition Database during the reporting period, is 2%. 77% of the Afghans who approached the VRCs were successfully enrolled; this excludes children under 5 years of age and those who did not undergo the IRIS test (due to disability, etc.). The age limit for the Iris recognition test was lowered from 12 to 5 years in July 2003.

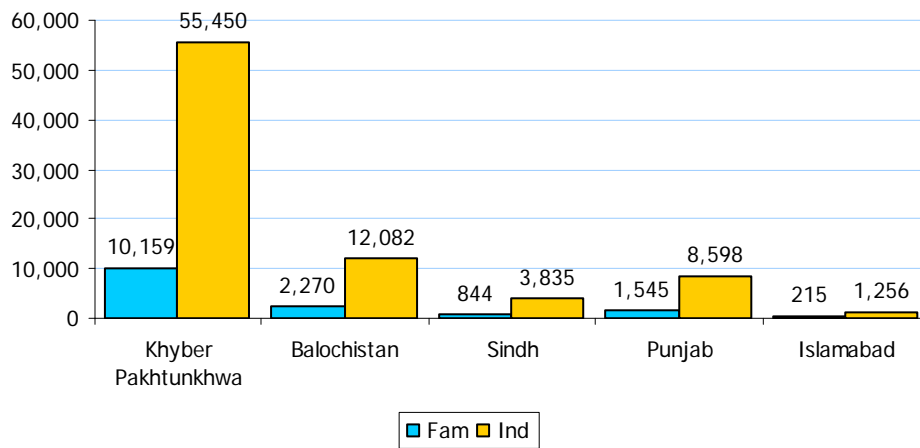
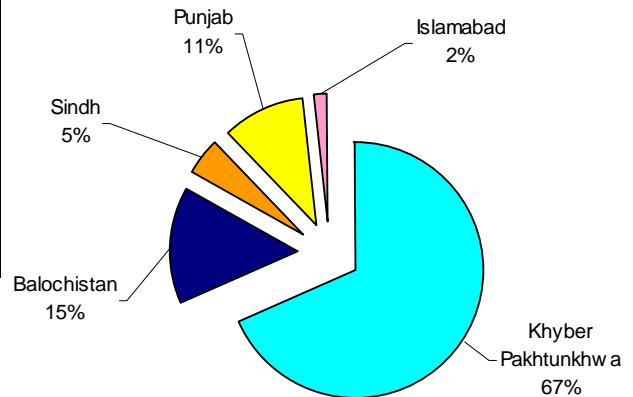
Note about the statistics

The figures in this report may appear different to those in the Daily Repatriation Reports. This is because repatriation data is collected manually in the field, submitted to respected sub-offices (Quetta / Peshawar) at the end of each day, then transferred to Branch Office Islamabad where all data is compiled and final reports are generated. There is a margin of error and a time delay in the processing so that while daily statistics may indicate one figure, the overall figures may reflect another.

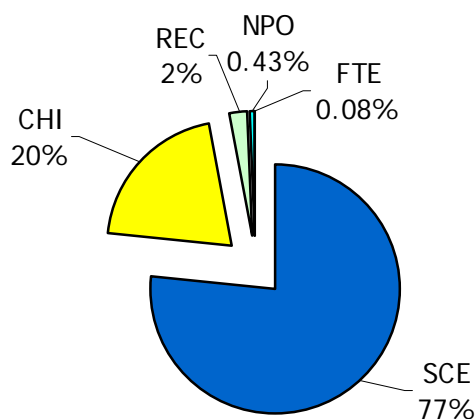

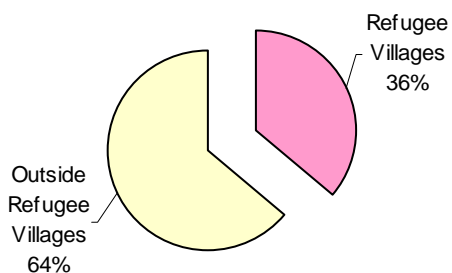
<u>Code</u>	<u>Description</u>
SCE	Successfully enrolled, i.e. Afghans passed the IRIS test, get enrolled in the database for the first time.
CHI	Children younger than 6 do not undergo the IRIS test except randomly.
FTE	Failure to enroll. This is not a rejection. An Afghan may not undergo the IRIS test because of medical reasons, e.g., blind or extreme cataracts.
NPO	Not performed for other reasons i.e. women may choose to forego the test for cultural reasons, in which case they are exempt from the cash grant.
REC	Recognized. The IRIS technology recognized the individual's iris. This is treated as attempt to apply for assistance twice.

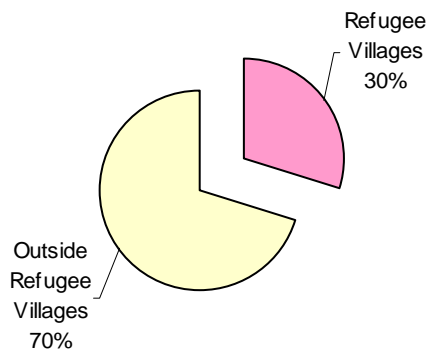

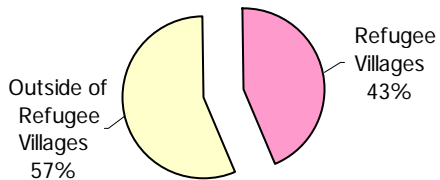
2010 RVs vs. Outside of RVs



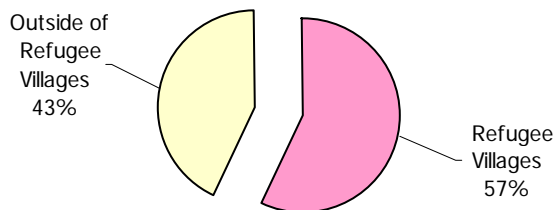
2009 RVs vs. Outside of RVs



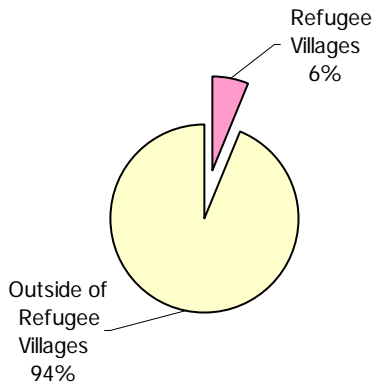
2008 RVs vs. Outside of RVs



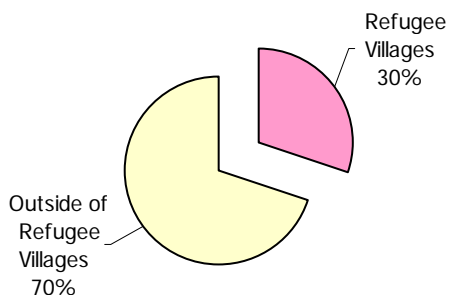
2007 RVs vs. Outside of RVs

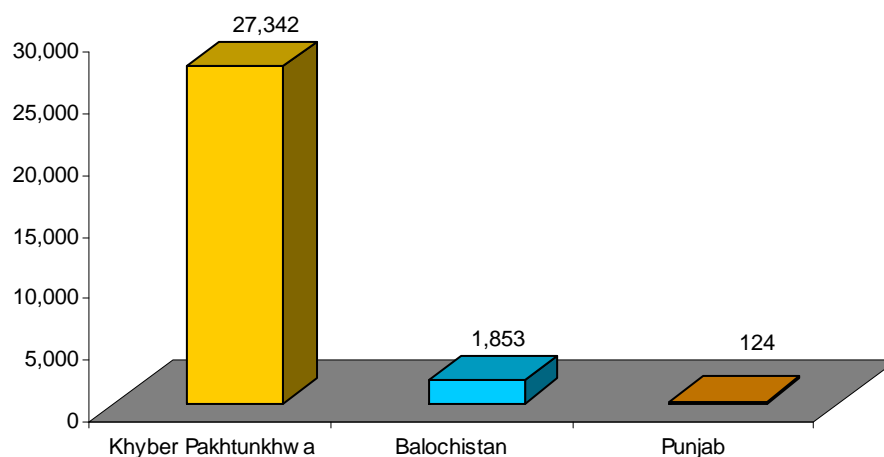

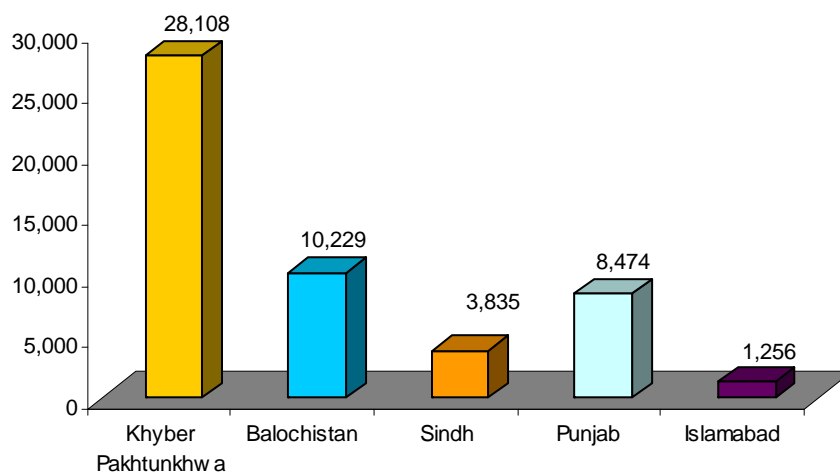

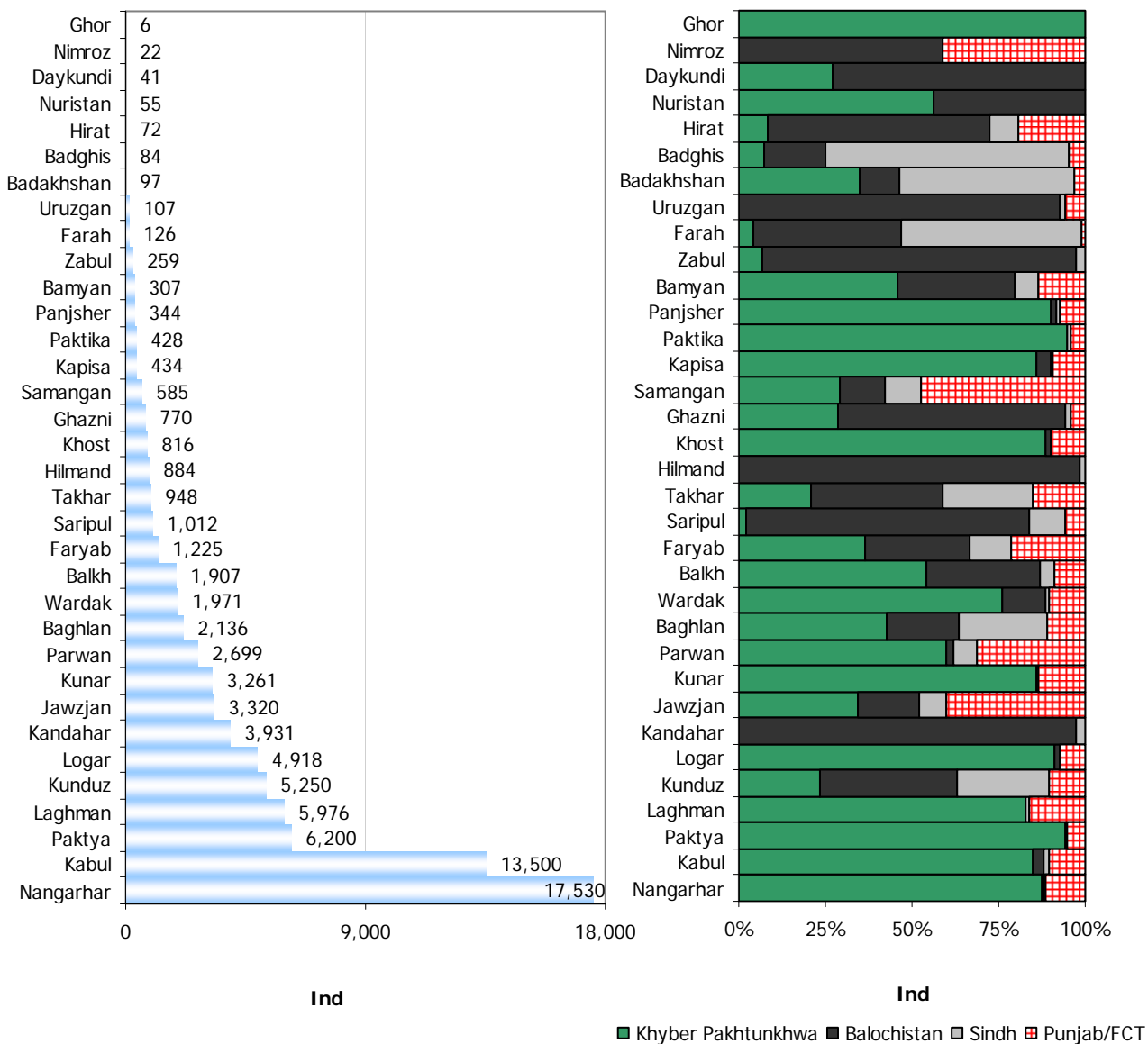

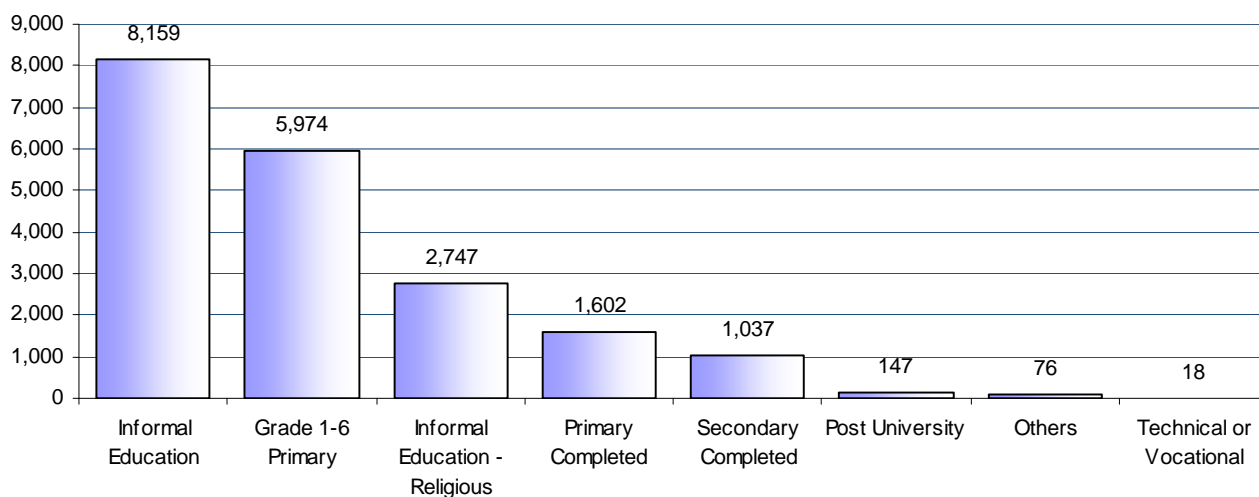
PROVINCE OF RESIDENCE AND INTENDED FINAL DESTINATION



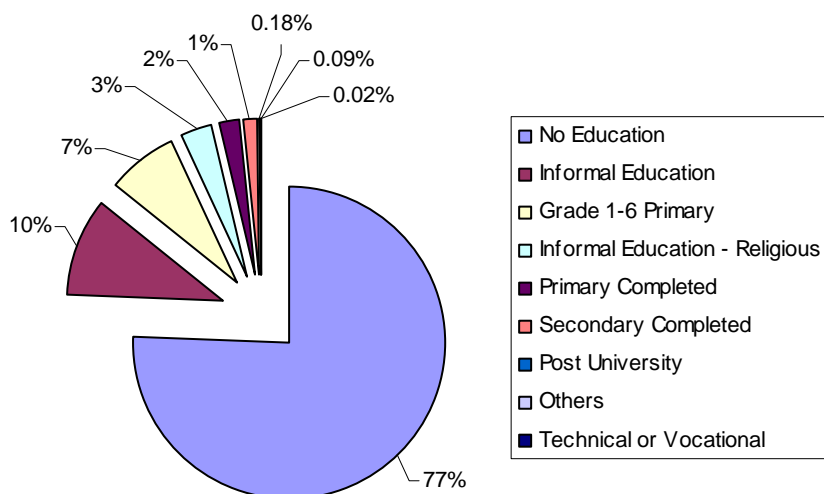

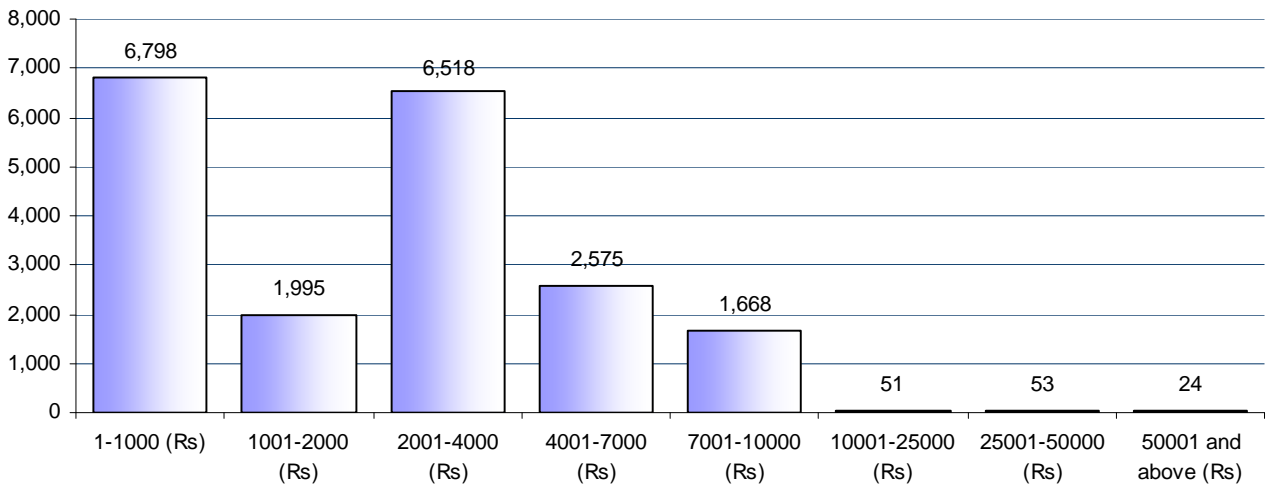

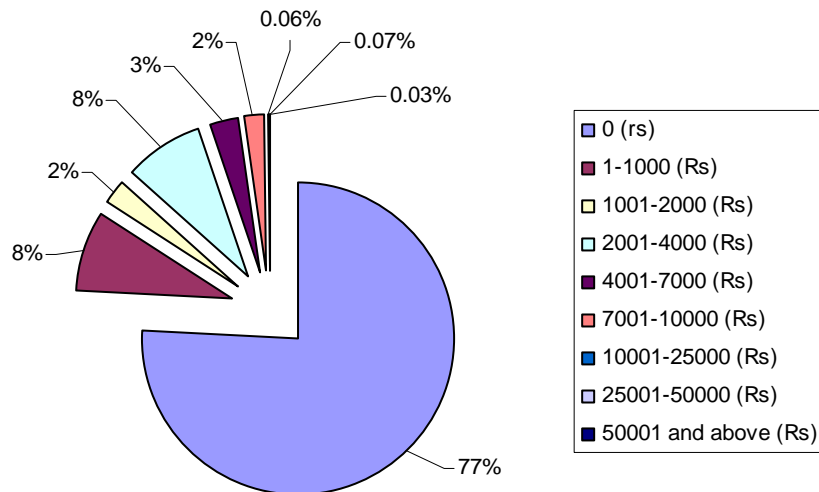

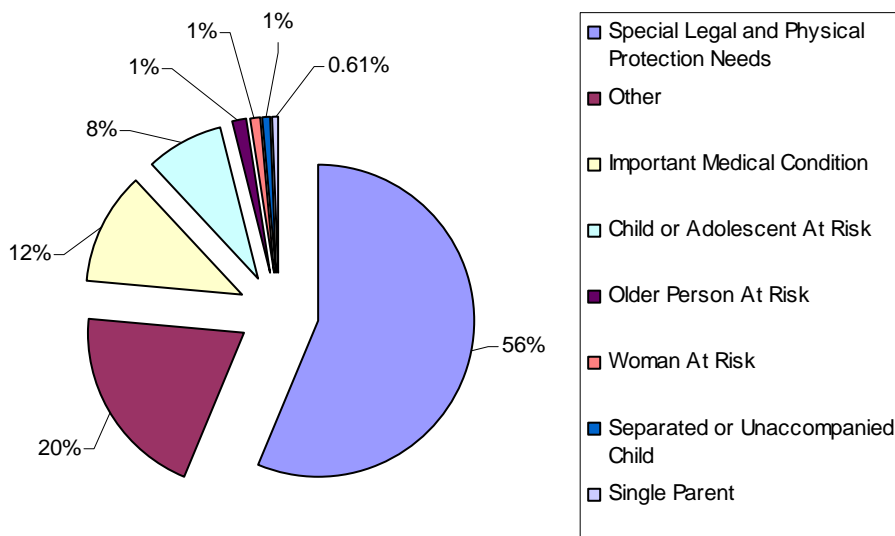

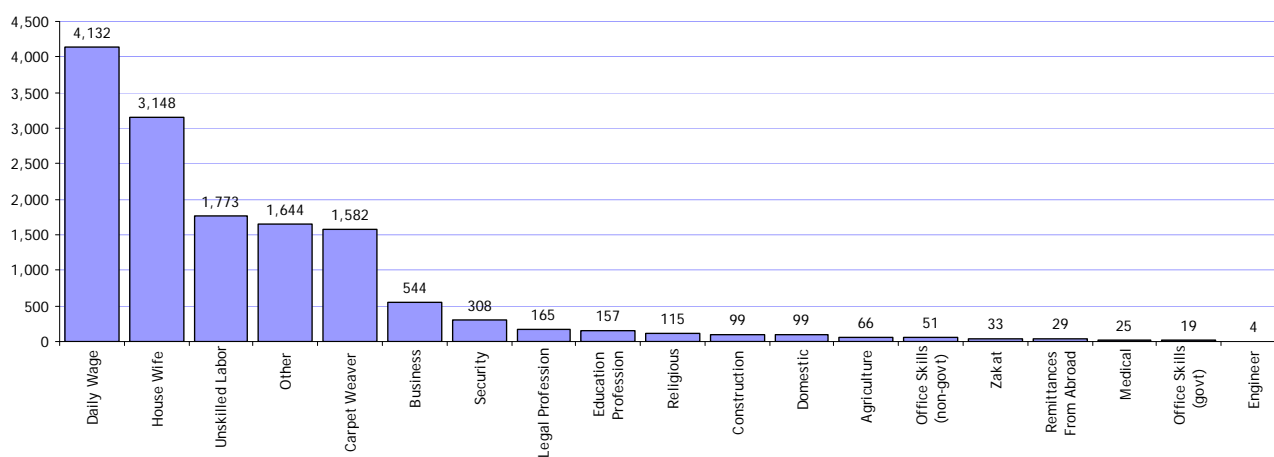
